BIG BEN MOVES UP: Roethlisberger moved into second place on the Steelers' all-time passing yardage list, ahead of Kordell Stewart.
 He has 13,359 yards, or fewer than half as many yards as Terry Bradshaw's 27,989 yards from 1970-83. This is Roethlisberger's fifth season.
 Wide receiver Hines Ward had a season-high nine passes for 116 yards, his first 100-yard game since Nov. 5, 2006, against Denver.
 This was the 17th 100-yard game of his career, the second-most in Steelers

...GAME NOTES: The Colts said their own in-game report that WR Marvin Harrison sustained a concussion was inaccurate. ... Steelers RB Willie Parker (shoulder) missed his fifth game in the last six, left tackle Marvel Smith missed a fourth consecutive game with back discomfort and linebacker LaMarr Woodley was out with an injured calf. ... Manning had not been sacked in three games until being sacked twice. Pittsburgh came into the game with a league-leading 32 sacks. ... Hines Ward made nine catches for 116 yards, with his 41-yard reception leading to Moore's second TD run. ... Roethlisberger has 8 interceptions in his last 10 quarters.
